The United Methodist Seminar Program is an essential component of the United Methodist Women's commitment to expanding concepts of mission.

Custom-designed seminars provide an opportunity for groups to:

EXPLORE issues through interactive exercises, Bible study and discussion.

ENGAGE with human rights activists, grass-roots organizations and religious leaders.

LEARN about the work of the U.S. government and the United Nations.

VISIT local community organizations.

ACT during the seminar and develop actions to take upon returning home.

Groups can select their own social justice topic.
